David applied for pension 27 Jul 1876. His wife applied for pension Jan 8 1878.

Born 16 Dec 1811. Died 16 Jul 1877, buried in East Cemetery, Waverly, Morgan Co., IL. His wife is also buried there.

She is found in the 1880 census, working at Central Hospital For The Insane, Jacksonville, Morgan, Illinois:
