He was living in Ottumwa, IA in 1890. In 1900 she was living with son, William, b.1860 and his wife Mazie, b, 1869 in IL. Martinette stated she was a widow, had 2 children, 2 living.

He applied for pension Jan 19 1885, no state listed, assumed to be IL. His wife, Martinette, applied for pension May 16 1898 from Iowa. He died 1 May 1898 in Ottumwa, Wapello Co., IA. He is buried in Ottumwa Cemetary
