In 1880 they were farming in Browning, Schuyler Co., IL. Rosa is not listed, there are 3 additional children, Cora M, \*, Flora M, 7 and Isaac V, 5.

In 1900 they were living in Macomb, McDonough Co., IL, retired. John was living with them.

Burgess was admitted to the Soldier's and Sailor's Home in Quincy, IL on Dec 18, 1890, patient number 1803. He listed his home as McDonough Co.

He applied for pension Nov 1, 1879, no state listed, assumed to be IL.

He was born 30 May 1830 and died Dec 22 1914 as reported by GAR Post 408, Colchester, IL He is buried in Camp Creek Cemetery(also known as Craig Cemetery), McDonough Co., IL per 1929 Honor Roll.
