In 1900 they were still living in the Ashland area. No additional children. Zylpha stated that they had been married 34 years and had 3 children, all living.

He applied for pension July 24 1879, no state listed, assumed to be IL. His wife, Zylpha, applied for pension March 24 1905 from IL.

He died Mar 15 1905 as reported by GAR Post 592 , Ashland, Cass Co., IL
