He lived in Hubble, Thayer Co., NE in 1890. He was getting a pension for two gunshot wounds to the face and feet.

He was a member of GAR Post 50 in Hubble, Thayer Co., Nebraska in 1891..

In the 1900 census they were farming in Richland TWP, Republic Co., Kansas. They had another son, William C, age 18, b. in IL. Amanda stated that they had been married 34 years, had 10 children, 7 living.

In the 1910 census, they lived in Jefferson, Republic Co., KS

In the 1930 he was living with William and family in Richland Twp, Republic Co., KS

He died July 11 1932 at Munden, Republic Co., KS
