He was born 26 May 1839. He applied for pension Mar 27 1880, no state listed, assumed to be from IL. His wife, Fannie, applied for pension May 6 1913 from Colorado. He is buried in Valley View Cemetery, Otero Co., Colorado. His death date not found, probably 1913.
