He was admitted to the Soldier's Home in Quincy IL on May 12, 1912, patient number 9792.

He applied for pension Jan 5 1880 and 15 Feb 1907, no state listed, assumed to be IL.

He was born in 1828. He died 21 Aug 1925 as reported by Quincy GAR Post, buried in Sheppard Cemetery, Morgan Co., IL
