He applied for pension July 24 1882 from Missouri. His wife, Sarah G.Heller, applied for pension 22 Dec 1916 from IL.

He was admitted to the Soldier's and Sailor's Home in Quincy, IL on Nov 18, 1898, patient number 4613. He was listed as living in Scott Co. In 1900 is listed in the census as being divorced and an inmate in the Soldiers and Sailors Home.
