Andrew, Matilda, and Jesse were living in Ward 7, Kansas City, Mo., in 1900. Andrew was working as a carpenter, Jesse as a painter. Matilda stated she had 1 child, 1 living.

He applied for pension September 21 1870, no state given, assumed to be IL. His wife, Matilda E., applied for pension April 16 1925 from Missouri.

He died April 8 1925, Kansas City, Missouri from a fractured skull after falling down stairs(source death certificate.. He is buried at Mt. Moriah Cemetery, Kansas City, Jackson Co., MO.
