Martha stated that she had 10 children, all living. In 1920 they were living in Altamont, Labette Co., KS.

James applied for pension Feb 26 1890 and Apr 8 1907 from Kansas. His wife, Martha, applied for pension Nov 27 1923 from KS.

He died Nov 16 1923 at Fort Hall, KS. James and Martha are both buried in Fort Scott National Cemetery, Bourbon Co., KS
