He is listed on the Jacksonville Civil War monument and the 1872 Morgan Co. History.  
Born 2 Aug 1844 in Monroe Co., Mich. Burial location unknown. A report was found of re-burial "in a nearby National Cemetery after the war, but no listing of any of the soldiers that died in Jackson was found.  
He is believed to have died from drinking "bad water" near Jackson. Several other in the regiment died also and several more were sick.. There was a report of a cholera outbreak, but no confirmation of this has been found.  
His parents were eligible for a pension as a result of his death, but no application was found. He was the younger brother of James M. Wood, below. No pension records found.
