After his first wife died in 1870, he apparently remarried, to Rebecca xxxx in 1875.

In 1880 they were living in Mendon, Chariton Co., MO. where he was farming.

In 1900 they were in Hopkins Twp, Nodaway Co., MO., farming. They had a daughter, Murlis, born August 1875 in Mo. Rebecca stated they had been married 25 years, had 1 child, 1 living.

He applied for pension Sep 7 1891 from MO. His wife, Rebecca, applied for pension May 18, 1923 from MO.

His wife, Rebecca and son, Charlie are buried in Concord Cemetery, Morgan Co., IL

He was born April 15 1843 in Jacksonville, IL and died April 23 1923 in Brookfield, Linn Co., MO
